

1. Prior to printing, ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box.
2. Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long.



- 1 You can easily find the circumference of your finger by using a measurement tool and a thread. Wrap the thread around the finger you want to measure, and mark the circumference on the band.
- 2 Use a ruler and measure the inches or millimeters that you just marked on the band. You can now find your Tom Wood ring size.
- 3 If your size is in between two sizes, we advice you to order the largest size. If you already own a ring, you can match with one of the circles on the chart underneath.
